1. How would you describe a residual haunt?
2. Have you ever experienced a residual haunt? If so, please share it with the group.
3. Are you sometimes indifferent to others around you at work, or in public places? Describe what that looks like.
4. Why might a ghost be afraid to interact with humans?
5. If Lucifer harms spirits that help humans, how does this help his master plan to conquer as many souls as possible?
6. Matthew 12:30 – Do you sometimes stay quiet in a contentious situation in order to avoid conflict? If so, how does your silence put you on one side of the issue?
7. Ecclesiastes 7:18 – What value is there in trying to understand both sides of an issue?
8. If doing God’s ministry involves hard work, pressure and taking us out of our comfort zone, then why should we do it?
9. Do we really gain peace by remaining silent on the hard issues?
10. Do you have friends or co-workers that always do the least amount of work possible? What is it like to work with them?
11. Do you think some humans are smarter or more gifted than others? If so, how does that impact God’s expectations of them?
12. Have you ever asked for something, and when it arrived, you didn’t know what to do with it? Compare that to a dullard who continually asks for the attention of a human, and doesn’t know what to do when he finally receives it.
13. How difficult is it for you to change your behavior? Are you sometimes repeating unproductive behavior over and over, yet expecting different results?
