4. Why do you think so much negativity comes from smells?
5. 1 Corinthians 12:14-18 – God says all the parts of the body please him. How can we learn to appreciate all parts of our body?
6. How do ghosts do lead us toward or drive us away from a certain place through the use of smell?
7. What do you think Lucifer smells like?
8. Ephesians 5:1-2 – What do you think the phrase “fragrant offering” means when we consider the sacrifice of Christ?
9. Discuss the significance of our sense of smell when considering one of the gifts the wise men brought to baby Jesus was incense.
10. How can we use our sense of smell to protect us from danger, as well as to protect us from ghosts?
11. Ezekiel 3:1-4 – Ezekiel is absorbing a scroll given to him from an angel. This scripture tells us he eats the scroll and it tastes as sweet as honey. What do you think this means?
