Chapter One – Ghosts Don't Exist

1. What do you say to convince someone that ghosts are real?
2. How do you convince a believer in ghosts that they are not real?
3. Why do you think some people see ghosts and others do not see them?
4. If we believe that the Bible is true, then regarding Revelations 12:8
 - a. Does this one Scripture prove that there is a Satan and he has angels?
 - b. Explain how demons were once angels.
5. Regarding Truth #1- "You have a choice" - Does this mean if we chose not to believe; we will never be bothered by ghost or demons?
6. Regarding Truth # 2 – "I cannot prove s exist" - Many things in this world cannot be proved- such as the big bang theory, UFO's, Yeti, etc... So what proof do we have of any such things? If someone believes that they saw the Yeti and took a picture...it that proof? What will determine "proof" for you?
7. Regarding Truth # 3 – "Spirits like to hide" - Is this why ghosts scare us? Are they as surprised to be with us as we are as surprised to see them?
8. Matthew 12:23- Does having the spirit of God in us give us the power to cast out "devils"?
9. How many other demons are as bad as Satan?
10. Luke 8:26-39- If the "demons" gave Jesus the name "Legion" (because they are many), how many demons can possess a single person?
11. Luke 8:26-39 - People knew this man had demons. After they were cast out he went to tell others what Jesus had done for him. What difference do you think people could see in him?
12. If Satan can masquerade as an angel of light, (Corinthians 11:13-15), how do we recognize him?
13. Do you believe demons talked about in the Bible are real or unidentified illnesses? Why or why not?
14. What could happen if you reject the reality of demons and you are a Christian?
15. Is there anyone with you, or have you had an experience with a ghost? Are they, or you, willing to share that story with other people, or has it been kept a secret?
